

He has expressed that instead of doing PhD on the subject which have dealt by many others one has to do the research on the current and important subjects which will be useful to the future generation, while he was



a research student in the Gulbarga University he had exhibited leadership quality by taking up the assignment of management of hostel. After completion of his post graduation and PhD. he joined Kuvempur University as Asst. Professor. He has explained the details of his achievement as NSS officer the Director of Distance Education Registrar Evaluation and his success stories connected to his assignments. He has also served as Registrar Academic in Tumkur University where he had come into close contact of Office Bearers of AVOPA which is continuing

till today. He is now working as Vice Chancellor of Tumkur University and completed two and half years which is a remarkable assignment in his carrier. He has received prestigious Mahatma Gandhi International Goodwill Award from the Office of the Governor of Karnataka. He has also received Education for Sustainable Development Excellence Award from the Indian Institute of Ecology and Environment, New Delhi.
