REPORT ON TECH SEMINAR HELD ON 17-03-2024

AVOPA TECH DAY held on 17th March 2024, at Indian Institute of World Culture.

Panel Discussion Topic 1 : The significance & Importance of Artificial Intelligence and its impact on the general public. The inaugural panel discussion featured three distinguished panellists: Dr. A S Gurudatt, Chairman of the Research Committee on IT at The ICAI; Dr. Ramesh Makam, a Laparoscopic Surgeon at A V Hospital; and Sri Ravi V Chitloor, a Senior Distinguished Engineer at Dell Technologies, moderated by Sri. C.K. Manjunatha.

Dr. A.S. Gurdatt spoke on Artificial Intelligence at different levels of Academics He discussed the



revolutionary changes occurring in academia, highlighting how students now have extensive access to AI for research, knowledge dissemination, and guidance. He outlined a range of tools and apps available for students to delve into knowledge exploration and stay updated with current technological trends. Additionally, he addressed the downside of AI, noting that students might miss the personal interaction and mentorship they traditionally received from teachers and peers in a gurukul and even miss the Guru Upadesham.

Dr. Ramesh Makam, spoke on AI in Health Care, He began by emphasizing a crucial point: AI cannot

replace the role of a doctor, but rather serves as a valuable assistant across various aspects of healthcare. This includes managing patient records, reducing the time required to interpret diagnostic reports, handling patient history, and utilizing chatbots for communication. He also cautioned against relying solely on online resources like Google for self-diagnosis, highlighting the potential risks and implications. Further, he provided insights into a variety of tools that can enhance healthcare practices.

Sri Ravi V Chitloor spoke on Governance and Commercial use of AI & Infrastructure building for AI, He spoke on how AI aligns with different horizontal technological frameworks and highlighted its capability to develop vertical solutions tailored to specific requirements. He outlined numerous opportunities in AI while also noting that certain tools should not be limited by locale. Additionally, he referenced Dr. Ramesh Makam's ideas shared during the panel discussion, which sparked discussions on potential AI startup ventures.

Panel Discussion Topic 2 : Startup Opportunities : The second panel discussion included three notable panelists: Sri Sandesh Cadabam, MD of Cadabams Group; Sri K L Prashanth, Partner at Guru & Jana Company; and Sri Naveen Lakkur, Founder of Inspiring Innovation, moderated by Sri. D. Naresh Babu

Sri Sandesh Cadabam spoke on Startups in Healthcare : He spoke the strategies for scaling a startup into a successful entrepreneurial venture, emphasizing the importance of consistency and expanding boundaries. Drawing from his personal journey as a case study, he highlighted the significance of securing seed funding and forging partnerships or collaborations with government entities to accelerate growth. Additionally, he stressed the necessity for startups to have a clear vision and the necessary resources, which are essential ingredients for success.

Sir. K.L Prashanth spoke on Compliance in Startups : He



imparted his expertise on establishing a startup entity, emphasizing that it has evolved from a mere concept to a recognized legal entity since 2016. He presented a comprehensive checklist outlining the steps involved in starting a startup, from registration to tax benefits extending over three financial years, with provisions for carrying forward losses within ten years of obtaining startup status. Furthermore, he provided an in-depth analysis of the current startup landscape in the country, highlighting the extent of government support for such ventures.

Sri Naveen Lakkur spoke on Innovations in startups : He began by likening the three panelists to Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva – where Brahma represents the seed of ideation, Vishnu embodies operational compliance, and Shiva symbolizes disruptive energy. He seamlessly integrated spiritual examples into his discussion on innovation. He elaborated on the concept of ideation and the process of implementing ideas, highlighting the crucial distinction between an idea with potential for successful business transformation and a mere conceptual notion. He commended that the entrepreneurial spirit is in the blood of Arya Vysya community.



The Technical Seminar commenced with the ceremonial watering of the Tulsi plant.

President Sri T.K. Thimmaraja Setty gave a welcome note, Sri. B.N. Ramesh Kumar – Chairman of Technical Seminar introduced all the guests, Ms. Shilpa Jagadeesh Boggaram invoked the blessings of Lord.
